Karen Pollack, Director of Community Relations at Springhouse Senior Living was named a recipient of the Sales and Marketing Excellence Award by the Massachusetts Assisted Living Association (Mass-ALA) at the organization's annual Excellence Awards Dinner on May 8, 2017. The awards are presented each year to individuals at every level of assisted living who have demonstrated their desire to make a positive difference in the lives of residents and who, in the view of their peers, stand out as role models in the industry.

Pollack cares deeply about the health and safety of all elders, and takes the time to educate herself, and others, about the programs and resources that benefit the elder community.
