Holiday Concert with David Won



Please join us for a holiday concert, featuring Tenor, David Won on Saturday, December 23rd at 2:00 p.m.

David Won entered Seoul Theological Seminary to study Church Music in 1980, and then transferred to Seattle Pacific University, where he received a BA in 1983. In 1986, he received a Master of Divinity from Asbury Theological Seminary, and in 1993 a Master of Theological Studies from Harvard Divinity School. He has always been deeply involved in music, particularly choral music. He has sung with Soong Sil OB Chorus, Korea Broadcasting Station Chorus, Harvard Glee Club, Church of the Advent of Boston under the direction of Edith Ho and recently Chorus pro Musica of Boston. In 2013, David was a featured soloist in the Great Mass in C Minor by Mozart with Chorus pro Musica and the New England Philharmonic, under the direction of Dr. Betsy Burleigh (currently Chair of Choral Conducting at Indiana University). Since December of 2014 he has been coached regularly with Timothy Steele, and with him several recitals were performed in the Greater Boston area to great acclaim. In May of 2016, David made his European debut in Padova and Venezia Mestre with recitals, and Cremona TV1 interview, Italy. David's first CD, "Languages of Love" in 6 different languages, was published in the fall of 2016. This appearance will be David's third performance at Springhouse, and will feature a program inspired by the holiday season.
