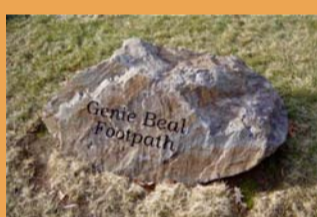
Love Story

We asked the Springhouse residents to submit their "Love Stories" for Valentines Day. This story resonated with us. On February 12, 1942, a bridesmaid and a best man were attendants at a wedding of a mutual friend. The two began a friendship, however, the best man was sent into WWII for a few years. Upon discharge, they reconnected and the relationship blossomed leading to marriage on May 29, 1948. They wed in the same church they had met at 6 years earlier as best man and bridesmaid. In Memory of Genie Beal



The newly installed memorial adjacent to the Woodside Entrance at Springhouse Senior Living is to commemorate the open space advocacy legacy of Genie Beal.

Genie was the founding member, long-time Board Chair, and guiding spirit of Boston Natural Areas Network. She also served on the Boston Conservation Commission in the 1970's at which time the Commission made it's first land acquisition of a 5-acre parcel off Allandale Street that is adjacent to current day Springhouse conservation land.

Genie last resided at Springhouse until the time of her death on August 28, 2013.

Lecture: Old & Sick in America The Journey Through the Health Care System

Muriel Gillick, MD will present her latest book
Wednesday, March 14 at 3:30 in Main Street

Since the introduction of Medicare and Medicaid in 1965, the American health care system has steadily grown in size and complexity. Muriel R. Gillick takes readers on a narrative tour of American health care, incorporating the stories of older patients as they travel from the doctor's office to the hospital to the skilled nursing facility, and examining the influence of forces as diverse as pharmaceutical corporations, device manufacturers, and health insurance companies on their experience. A scholar who has practiced medicine for over thirty years, Gillick offers readers an informed and straightforward view of health care from the ground up, revealing that many crucial medical decisions are based not on what is best for the patient but rather on outside forces, sometimes to the detriment of patient health and quality of life. Gillick suggests a broadly imagined patient-centered reform of the health care system with Medicare as the engine of change, a transformation that would be mediated through accountability, cost-effectiveness, and culture change.
